## DESCRIPTION

Human Nature led the master planning and site design for this park so that the Northern Kentucky Sanitation District (SD1) could serve as a regional model for stormwater best management practices (BMPs). Features of the site include: a green roof, permeable pavements, wetland filters, a small lake, a stormwater garden and outdoor classroom for teaching, an above-ground aqueduct and cistern for the storage and reuse of rainwater, trails, an amphitheater, two overlooks to the Banklick Creek, and a tribute to those in public service. The facility is open to the public and serves as a laboratory for teaching the next generations of children, developers, local communities and public agencies for caring about our water resources. In 2002 The Kentucky Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects recognized SD1 with the Honor Award with Excellence, and in 2007 the Green Roofs for Healty Cities recognized SD1 with the Green Roof Award of Excellence.
